What Are We Learning?

We are learning to recite (say) numbers in order to ten.

How to Set up the Challenge

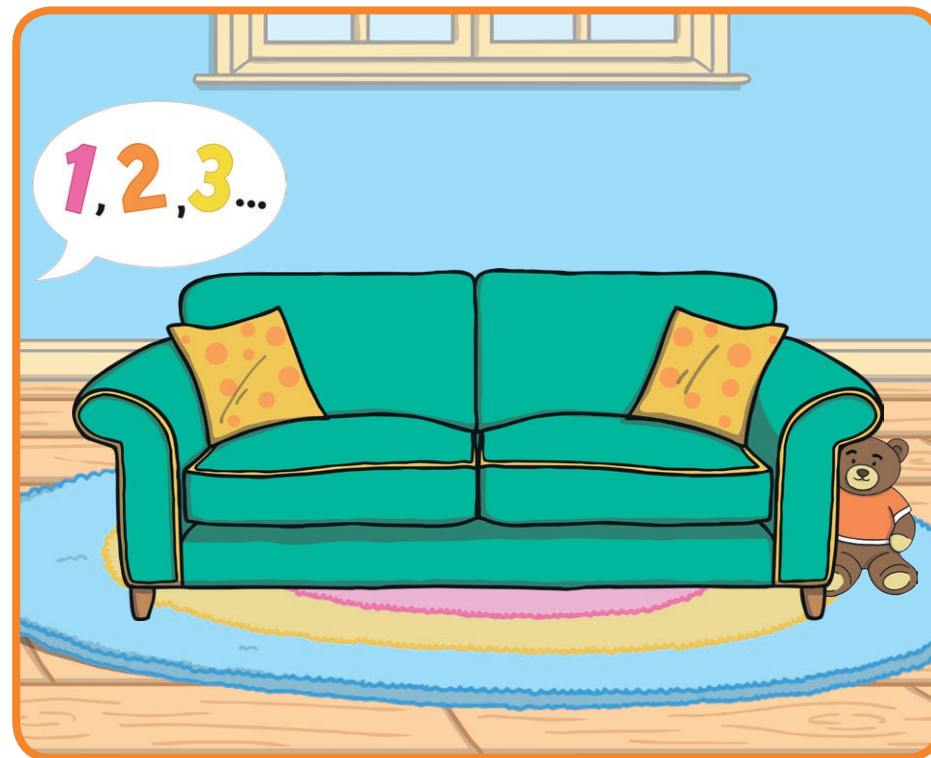
- Find a small toy, such as a doll, teddy bear or plastic dinosaur.
- This will be used to play a 'Hide and Seek' game in which the toy will be hidden as numbers to ten are said. The child will then look for and find the toy before swapping roles with you.

How to Get Your Child Thinking

- Did I say all of the numbers to ten?
- What number comes after five?
- When you recite the numbers, make some deliberate mistakes such as:
 - Missing some numbers out, e.g. "One, two, three, eight, nine, ten."
 - Say the numbers in the wrong order, e.g. "One, five, seven, two, six, four, three, eight, ten, nine."
- Can the child spot these mistakes, and say the numbers in the correct order?



Can You Count as the Toys Hide?



- Can you say the numbers to 10 as your toy hides?
- Can you find your toy once you have said the numbers?
- Can you help your toy hide as someone else says the numbers to 10?
