- Protecting children and vulnerable adults.



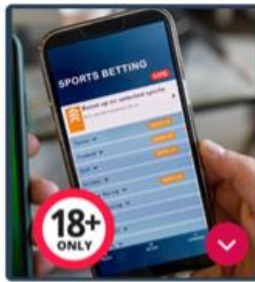
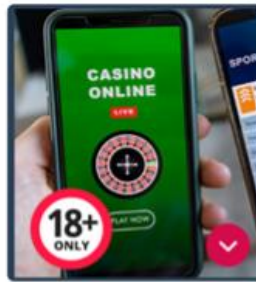
Why do we have laws and age restrictions on gambling?
