



Pre-School Provision and Prices September 2025

Please find below the enhanced provision and pricing structure for Haydon Abbey Pre-School. This includes session times and any associated fees, including information on Early Years wraparound care.

Sessions and Fees

To help your child settle in and thrive, we require your child to attend either **5 morning, 5 afternoon or 5 all day sessions** each week. If you require additional sessions above your funded hours, we are also pleased to offer the opportunity to purchase additional sessions (subject to availability).

Morning Session	8.45am – 11.45am	Funded 15 hours
Afternoon Session	12.30pm – 3.30pm	Funded 15 hours
All Day Session (packed lunch to be provided)	8.45am – 2.45pm	Funded 30 hours
Additional Sessions	8.45am – 11.45am OR 12.30pm – 3.30pm	£18 (If not funded)

The funded provision which we currently provide subject to availability:-

3 & 4-Year-Old (term after 3rd birthday)

- 15 Hours – universal
- 30 Hours – for eligible working parents

2-Year-Old (term after 2nd birthday)

- 15 or 30 hours – for eligible working parents
- 15 hours – for parents receiving certain benefits

If we have availability you may pay for sessions prior to being eligible for your funding entitlement

- Funding celebration days, seasonal crafts, events like Christmas, Diwali or end of term celebrations
