I know that weather changes when it gets colder outside. I know the names of the core people in my family, like recognising Mummy, Daddy, or a sibling in a photo. I know the names of my basic body parts, like identifying my nose, toes, or tummy when asked. I know who my key person is and look to them when I need comfort.	I know what mine and yours means when sharing toys with my friends. I know the difference between things that are big and things that are small. I know that ice feels cold to the touch and playdough feels sticky. I know that celebrations like Diwali and Christmas involve bright, colorful lights.

I know that pressing a button or lifting a flap makes something happen, showing cause and effect. I know the routine of the day and can predict what comes next, like knowing that snack time comes right after tidy-up time. I know the names of common winter things, like snow, frost, and warm hats.	I know that plants and flowers grow out of the green grass and dirt in the garden. I know that people look different from each other, like recognising that a friend wears glasses or has different hair. I know that special days like Pancake Day, Easter, or Ramadan involve sharing special foods and music.

I know that living things, like garden plants or animals from the petting farm, are fragile and must be treated gently. I know what happens when things mix together, like knowing that adding water to sand makes it turn into gooey mud. I know the names and sounds of common animals, like recognising a frog says ribbit or a dog says woof.	I know the names of familiar places in my local environment, like the park or supermarket. I know what it feels like when my body is hungry, thirsty, or needs a clean nappy, and I know how to signal it to an adult. I know who my friends are in my room and can identify them by name.
