Year 5 Production – Tuesday 19th & Wednesday 20th May 2026

Year 5 are very busy rehearsing for our production, which is a musical celebration of the world we live in. This performance will take the place of 5MM and 5SJ assemblies.

All children are required to **wear full school uniform** for the production. Any props used in the production will be provided by the school.

Please could we ask that you continue to encourage your child to be learning their lines/songs at home.

The performance for parents/carers, is taking place on: **Tuesday 19th May at 2pm and Wednesday 20th at 9:30am**. The production will take place in the school hall and **all adults need to arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the start of the play**. There will be **no admittance once it has started**.

For health and safety reasons, we are only allowed to have a certain number of people in the school, we will have a printed list of booked tickets therefore there is no need for you to print yours out. The performance will last for **approximately one hour**. **Tickets are limited to 2 tickets per family** (across both days) due to the size of the Year 5 year group. Please ensure that you book your free tickets by – **Friday 15th May** (please note that it may close sooner if we reach max capacity)
